Greetings to all my John W Weeks family and friends! I pray that this newsletter finds you all well and having a prosperous and happy year. We are planning a fantastic reunion this year in Dayton, Ohio.

As you may know, the Association planned to have a reunion in Dayton twice before, but we had to cancel because of the pandemic. Our

me at 417-781-4752. Hotel reservations can be cancelled up to 24 hours before the reunion for a full refund. All rooms that were blocked for the reunion have already been taken. Our contract with the hotel, however, allows anyone coming to the reunion to obtain hotel rooms at the contracted rate up until the start of the reunion if there are rooms available. Once the hotel sells out of rooms, we will not be able to obtain more rooms. When we scheduled our first reunion in Dayton, the hotel we were staying at was sold out of rooms four months before the reunion. If you think you may come to the reunion, make reservations for

your room now. You can always cancel and get a full refund. You are competing with everyone who wants a room in Dayton and once sold out, there are no more rooms.

The John W Weeks DD-701 was launched and the first crew came aboard in May 1944. Except for a few months in 1950, the John W Weeks was in service until August 1970, when she was decommissioned. During these 26 years, the ship played a critical role in world and naval events. She served in World War II, Korea, the Cuban missile crisis, Vietnam and in other areas of conflict. The John W Weeks family was born as the first members came aboard the ship. This family consists of more than just those who served aboard the ship. The Weeks family also consists of wives, children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. It is amazing that 55 to 80 years after serving on the ship, the bonds of love are strong and members regularly communicate and do things with each other. They are there to help each other and support each other in many ways. It is a blessing to have the family we have. Everyone is important no matter when they served or what rank or job they had.

Reunion is about the family of the USS John W Weeks coming together to visit, go on tours, and see people they may not have seen in years, meet new people, and to tell their stories. This reunion is going to be special. The people planning to attend include a plank owner who served in World War II 80 years ago, the last person to stand watch on the ship, the person who was there when the Weeks was buried at sea, people who were there for the last war time deployment to Vietnam, and people who were on the ship at different periods of time. Some have attended several reunions, and several others will be attending their first reunion. I also want to stress the importance of having wives and family at the reunion. Wives have as much fun as we crew members of the ship do.

There is a lot to see and do in and around Dayton. Many of the attractions are low cost or free. Some of the attractions include the Oregon District where you can shop, dine and relax in the open air. The Packard Museum, our two-hour guided tour for Thursday, has the largest collection of Packard automobiles and memorabilia anywhere in the world, with cars from 1908 to 1958. Carillon Historical Park is our second tour for Thursday. This is a 65-acre park and museum which contains historical buildings and exhibits concerning the history and technology and the history of Dayton and its residents from 1796 to the present. It also includes the Wright Brothers National Museum. The National Museum of the U.S. Air Force galleries, our tour for Friday, presents military aviation history, including Navy, boasting more than 360 aerospace vehicles, and missiles on display.

I want to thank all the officers of the Association and members of the USS John W Weeks family that have done so much to prepare for this reunion and have done so much to support the Association. A big "well done" to everyone. I am very much looking forward to seeing everyone at the reunion.
